

## UMKC SCHOOL OF MEDICINE – CLINICAL TRAINING FACILITY

### Rate Sheet – Non-Affiliated Institutions

The Clinical Training Facility is a multi-disciplinary medical skills and simulation laboratory located on the Hospital Hill campus of the University of Missouri – Kansas City under the auspices of the School of Medicine. The Skills Lab offers a classroom facility for lectures and simulation observation, an exam room suite that is suitable for standardized patient encounters or breakout skills sessions, an operating room, and a large lab space that can be configured for a variety of simulation scenarios as well as be sub-divided.

The Skills Lab features Laerdal manikins including the SimMan™ 3G, SimMan™ Classic, and an adult and child SimPad™ ALS simulators. There is also a Noelle™ OB manikin and an Infant Hal™. Simulations can be conducted with the instructor at the bedside, or from a control room that manages simulator operation as well as audio-video recording. Rounding out the Skills Lab features are a variety of task trainers, laparoscopic trainers, video laryngoscopy equipment, and prehospital/EMS equipment.

The Clinical Training Facility is available for rental by affiliated institutions as well as non-affiliated institutions and private industry. Activities should be related to healthcare and healthcare skills training or simulation.

- Reservations are requested a minimum of thirty days in advance.
- Reservations for space are on a first-come, first-served basis; however, the Skills Lab reserves the right to cancel reservations to serve our priority groups that consist of School of Medicine students and residents.
- Hourly rates are billed to the quarter hour
- The half day rate is a reservation of 4 hours (not pro-rated for late arrival/early departure), and the full day rate is a reservation of 8-9 hours (8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.)

<b>Classroom</b> Two classrooms are available that can be combined into one classroom. Each classroom seats 24 and has a computer and projector.	<u>Single Classroom</u> \$43.00/hour \$156.00/half day \$281.00/day	<u>Combined Classroom</u> \$78.00/hour \$281.00/half day \$500.00/day
<b>Operating Room</b> A single OR with an operating table, counter, headwall gases, and anesthesia machine and cart.		\$50.00/hour \$180.00/half day \$350.00/day
<b>Exam Room</b> There are four exam rooms available with a common staging/debriefing room. Each exam room contains an exam table, physical examination equipment, and a sink. These rooms may also be used for small group breakout skills rooms.		\$25.00/hour \$100.00/half day \$200.00/day
<b>Exam Room Suite (4 exam rooms and debrief area)</b> See description above.		\$125.00/hour \$500.00/half day \$1000.00/day
<b>Large Lab Room</b> The large skills lab room contains three bays with headwall gases, examination equipment, crash carts and monitoring equipment. These areas are designed for use with the human patient simulators.	<u>Single Bay</u> \$43.00/hour \$156.00/half day \$281.00/day	<u>All Bays</u> \$187.00/hour \$675.00/half day \$1250.00/day
<b>Simulator Operator</b> If the group using the lab is utilizing a simulator and does not have a trained operator who is acceptable to the Skills Lab manager, or requires an operator, this fee will be charged. The fee is based on the number of hours or quarters of an hour that the operator is actively engaged to conduct simulation.		\$52.00/hour/operator
<b>After hours surcharge</b> (All hours scheduled outside of 8:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday)		\$30.00/hour
<b>Simulator Materials Fee</b> (per-day when any human patient simulator or video recording is used) Many of our simulators have skins or parts that must be replaced after a certain number of uses. Our simulators also require ongoing maintenance. This fee will be assessed to those users of high-fidelity manikins to defray this cost.		\$30.00/manikin/day
<b>Standardized Patients</b> Standardized patients may be provided for activities either as patients or confederates in a simulation case. All standardized patients must be booked thirty days in advance through the SP Coordinator. Case-specific information will be required at the time of booking. If training of the SP is required outside of the actual event, it will be billed at this rate.		\$33.00/hour/pt.
<b>Expendable Supplies</b> (IV catheters, trays, kits, packaged items that cannot be re-used) The Skills Lab provides common supplies such as exam gloves, linens, tape, dressings, and gauze as a part of its normal operations. Many of our items are repackaged and re-used; however, if items are requested that cannot be re-used and must be purchased or replaced such as suture, simulated medications, line trays, sterile gloves, and one-time use simulator skins, these will be billed at our replacement cost.
