**Break down of Rotations:**

**Total rotations over 5 year program:**                      **65 blocks**

**Total Clinical rotations:**                                      **12 of 65 blocks**

- 2 blocks are radiology electives
- 10 blocks (Internal Med/ICU, Orthopedics, Neurology, OBGYN, Cardiology and Pediatrics)

**Total Radiology rotations:**                                      **53 of 65 blocks**

- Required core radiology rotations: 38 of 53
- **Electives: 17 of 53** (includes 2 from clinical year)
  - Electives vary depending on resident interests
  - Research electives may include 1 mo per year starting as PGY2
