## **Creating Objectives for Study and Readings Months**

The School of Medicine requires that every month taken for medicine credit have goals and objectives related to the 6 UMKC Competencies. The competencies are as follows:

Interpersonal and Communication Skills

Medical Knowledge

Practice-based Learning and Improvement

Systems-based Practice

Patient Care

Professionalism

For each study/readings month, students must create their own objectives for these competencies. An objective is not simply a topic of study (such as "hypertension" or "pathology review")—it is a statement of <u>what you will do</u> during the month to show you have achieved these competencies.

To help you with writing objectives, sample statements for each competency are given below. You may use these as a guide; however, your own statements should be tailored to your individual situation.

Systems-based Practice	"I will seek out advice on my study plan from my docent, ETC, and/or the education specialist."

Patient Care	"I will practice what I have learned about hypertension in generating my
	workup and plan in the continuing care clinic and discuss evidence of improvement with my docent or senior partner."
	"I will work to improve my decision-making in caring for patients with hypertension in the continuing care clinic."
Professionalism	"I will adhere responsibly to the study schedule and seek out assistance if
	I am struggling."
	"I will follow the recommendations of the education specialist to meet my learning objectives."
