



## Osteopathic Designation Eligibility

### **MD graduates:**

#### **I. Pre-matriculation**

Must notify UMKC Family Medicine Residency Program (UMKC FMR) of intention to apply for Osteopathic Designation 20 business days before the contract start date for PGY1 **and**:

- Must graduate from a Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) accredited medical school. International Medical Graduates must follow the UMKC Graduate Medical Education (GME) Recruitment and Appointment Policy and Procedure eligibility policy.

- Complete 60 hours of Osteopathic Principles and Practice (OPP) instruction from a Commission on Osteopathic College Accreditation (COCA) accredited medical institution. Certificate of completion must be provided.

- Verification that the candidate completed the Core Osteopathic Recognition Readiness Exam (CORRE) examination with a passing score.

- Letter of recommendation from an Osteopathic Physician (D.O.) with an active practice (letter must indicate that applicant understands OPP).

### **DO graduates:**

#### **I. Pre-matriculation**

- Must graduate from a COCA accredited college of osteopathic medicine.
